Catamount Families:

### In-Person Cohort Rotations

Students assigned to Cohort 2 (letter B in PowerSchool) will start in-person rotations on Wednesday, February 17. Students on Cohorts 1 and 3 (A and C in PowerSchool) will remain on remote learning until the week their cohort is assigned to come to school. Please review the WCPSS calendar at the link provided. As a reminder, on RL (Remote Learning) days, no students will come to the building.

**Notes about February 23 and February 24**

Since many of our teachers will be involved with ACT testing, Tuesday, February 23, will be a Remote Learning/Asynchronous day for all students. Only Juniors will report to campus that day to take their ACT test. All learning activities for the day will be asynchronous – there will be no live sessions.

Wednesday, February 24 was already designated a district Remote Learning day. All students will be learning remotely at home, but there will be live sessions each period with their teachers.



## **Student Services Information**

**February 18, 2021 during SMART Time – CCP-** Students can learn more information about Career and College Promise at NC Community Colleges and its process. Career & College Promise (CCP) is North Carolina's dual-enrollment program for high school students. Through Career & College Promise, qualified high school students in North Carolina have the opportunity to pursue dual-enrollment options tuition free while they are in high school, allowing them to get a jumpstart on their workplace and college preparation.
