### Plan B/Cohort Rotations

As you have heard, high school students who are assigned to a Plan B/in-person cohort rotation will start Wednesday, February 17th. This will only be for students assigned to Cohort 2 (B in PowerSchool). Students on Cohorts 1 and 3 (A and C in PowerSchool) will remain on remote learning until the week their cohort is assigned to come to school. Please review the WCPSS calendar at the link provided. As a reminder, on RL (Remote Learning) days, no students will come to the building.
