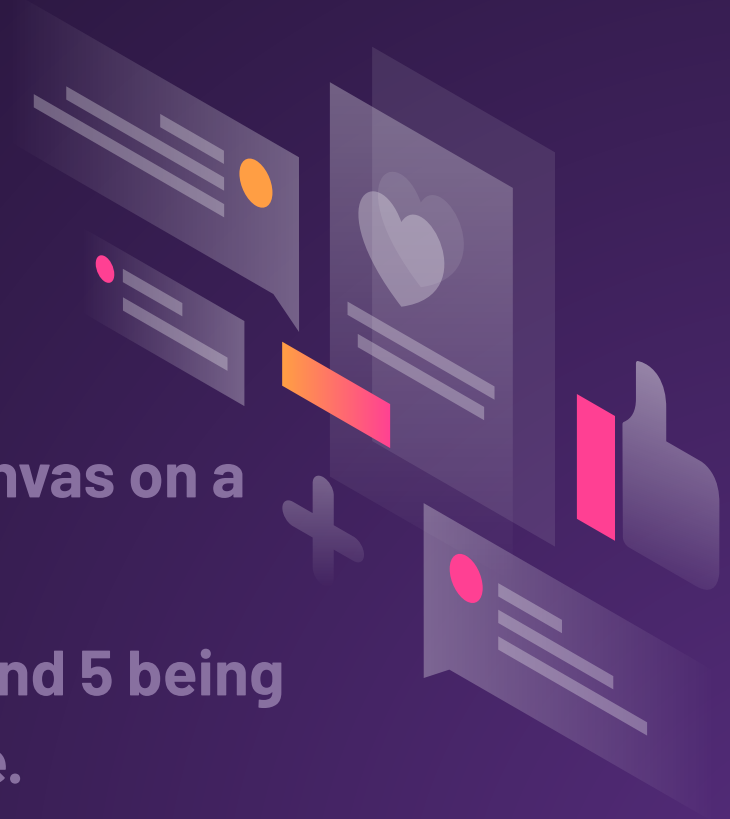

Setting up your child for success!

- Establish a calm, quiet, distraction-free space for your student to work every day.
- Make sure their virtual learning equipment is available and charged.
- Create a consistent schedule for completing assignments.



Setting up your child for success!

- Make sure your student checks Canvas every day and provide them help when needed.
- Check your email, Canvas Parent Observer Account, and PowerSchool regularly for communication and information. Need to update your email address? Contact your school's data manager.



Setting up your child for success! Cont...

- Communicate with teachers as needed regarding any questions or issues that arise.
- Serve as a partner in supporting your student in engaging in independent learning activities and credit requirements. Students will need different levels of support in online instruction and may need closer supervision and assistance from members of your student's support system.

Best Ways to Support your Child during virtual learning.



1. Stay up to date with school and district information.

Make sure you are signed up to receive text and email notifications from your child's school and from the school district. [SchoolMessenger](#)

I send a newsletter about twice a month with important information.



2. Know what resources are available.

Get the login information to WakeID portal for your student. This will allow you to login and see what resources are available to your student(s) and give you insight into the work that needs to be done.



3. Get notified of assignments.

Download the Canvas app to your smartphone or tablet. Once you download the apps needed, you can login as your student and get notifications when assignments are due.

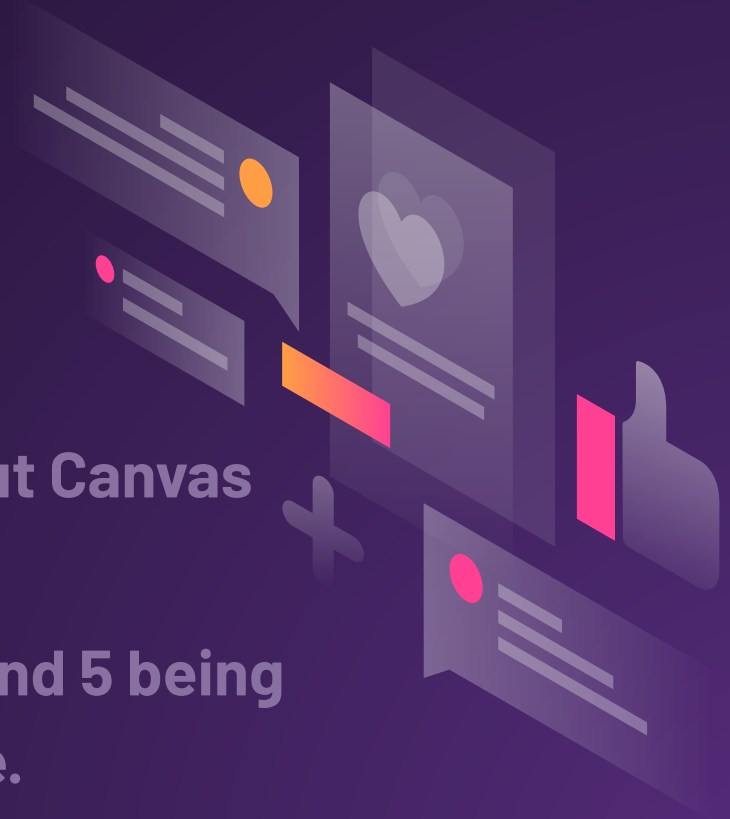
