AP Exam Registration Information and Deadlines

for Home-School and Self-Study Students

The 2021 AP Exams will be administered over two weeks in May: May 3 – 7 and May 10 – 14.

This document provides AP exam request and registration information for Home-School and Self-Study students. Self-Study refers to a Green Hope or WCPSS student who is not taking the AP course at Green Hope during the 2020-2021 school year. Please follow these directions to set up or retrieve your account with CollegeBoard and submit your AP exam request(s):

Action Items for Students:

- Go to myap.collegeboard.org.
 - If you already have established a CollegeBoard account, make certain that you can log in.
 - If you have forgotten your password, you may call 888-225-5427 or click "Forgot Password."
- Complete <u>REGISTRATION REQUEST FORM</u> by **October 9, 2020**. Please note that we are unable to accommodate Self-Study and Home-School exam requests after October 9, 2020.
- Students will receive an email from Green Hope Student Services by **October 20, 2020** indicating whether the AP exam request(s) is approved, total fees associated with the AP exam(s), deadline to submit payment, and the join code(s) specific to each AP exam.
- All Home-School and Self-Study students will log into their CollegeBoard accounts to register for their AP exams.
- Students will follow prompts in their CollegeBoard account to join the **"exam-only"** section for the course by **November 2, 2020**.

<u>Fees</u>

What is the cost for AP exams?

- \$95 per exam for Self-Study students (students not enrolled in the AP course during the 2020-2021 school year)
- **\$95** per exam for Home-School students

- Payment options and deadlines will be included in the AP exam request confirmation email. Students/parents will receive this email from Green Hope Student Services by **October 20, 2020**.

Additional Information

- Exam Schedule Conflicts
 - If a student has two exams at the same time, one of the exams will be taken in a late testing session.
 Students will receive notice from Mr. McIntyre about the test, time, and location closer to the exam administration.
