- PLEASE READ -

- All exams are in person.
- Students must bring their charged Wake County issued Chromebook to take their EOC/CTE exams.
- Exams will count as 20 percent of the student's final grade. The exam grade will impact the final course average either positively or negatively depending on the student's grades.
- If a student does not take the exam, their teacher may enter a zero into the course average.
- Seniors are not exempt from EOC/CTE exams. Seniors with a projected final course average of C or higher are eligible to be exempt from a teacher made final exam. For this school year, absences will not be considered in determining exemption status. Any questions, see your teacher.
- Teacher-made final exams may take the form of a traditional assessment, cumulative project or presentation, or other appropriate means of assessing the standards of the course.
- Virtual Academy and NCVPS Students: All EOC/CTE exams will be taken in person at their base school. All teacher-made exams will be taken virtually.
- Students will be dismissed to the cafeteria when their exam session has ended and can be picked up at that time. Otherwise they will remain on campus and attend a review session for their next period class.
