Schedule Information:

- All administrations of post assessments must be in person as required by state policy. **Students may not take these exams from home.**
- Students should bring their WCPSS Chromebooks and charger with them to their testing site The device must be fully charged and prepared for testing.
- Students will be allowed to leave campus after the testing session if they have a signed permission slip EACH DAY - [Print copies of the permission slip here](#)
- Students must remain in their assigned rooms for the duration of the exam block
 - Students may leave at the end of the testing session if all students are done testing with a signed permission slip. One per day.
- **Teacher made dismissal** Teacher made exams may be released for dismissal with a permission slip as early as 9:45am if all students have completed testing. If students are riding a bus or don't have a permission slip, they stay with the teacher until 11:40am for lunch.
- **CTE Exam dismissal** CTE exams may be released for dismissal with a permission slip as early as 9:45am if all students have completed testing in that room. If students are riding a bus or don't have a permission slip they stay with the teacher until 11:40am for lunch.
- **EOC Exam dismissal** EOC students may not be released for dismissal until the entire class is done testing if they have a permission slip to leave. If students are riding a bus or don't have a permission slip they stay with the teacher until 11:40am for lunch.
- **Make up testing: If you miss your exam you must communicate with your instructor**
- **CTE Post Assessment Courses include:** Agriscience Applications, Animal Science II (Companion Animal), Apparel & Textile Production I & II, Career Management, Financial Planning I (Field Test), Food and Nutrition I, Food and Nutrition II, Foundations of Health Science, Health Science I (Field Test), Interior Design Fundamentals, Business Essentials (Field Test), Principles of Family and Human Services and Project Management I.
- **EOC courses include:** English 2, Math 1, Biology, Math 3 (NCVPS in these subjects included)
- **EOC Testing Times**
 - **Biology: estimated 120 mins with a maximum testing time of 180 mins (without accommodations)**
 - **English 2: estimated 150 mins with a maximum testing time of 240 mins (without accommodations)**
 - **Math 1: estimated 180 mins with a maximum testing time of 240 mins (without accommodations)**
 - **Math 3: estimated 180 mins with a maximum testing time of 240 mins (without accommodations)**

***Students may use the maximum number of minutes for testing if needed**

*** Students with accommodations will be given their extended time**

Senior Exam Exemptions

For the 2022-2023 school year, students in Grade 12 may be exempt from **non-state exams (state exams include EOC and CTE courses)** and field tests based on the following criteria: Students who have a projected final course average of C or higher are eligible to be exempt. Absences will not be considered in determining exemption status for the 2021-2022 school year. The principal has final authority to determine a student's exemption status.

***Teachers must communicate with all seniors that are exempt no later than January 12th. If students have not reached exemption status by Jan. 12th, they will not be exempt from their exams. ***
