For World Languages, students can choose either French OR Spanish, not both. RHS recommends that students take World Languages beginning in 10th grade unless they already earned a WL credit in Middle School. It is recommended that students who do decide to take a world language course in 9th grade also be enrolled in English I Honors.

‡ Indicates a yearlong (2 semester) course; Students will be required to take both semesters if enrolled in these courses.
