Reading & Writing

Writing: At the beginning of May we will be writing a time travel adventure story, set in Revolutionary War times! We will focus on developing the narrative by adding description, dialogue, character feelings and action.

Reading: In preparation for the EOG, we will review and practice essential 4th grade reading skills such as using text evidence, main ideas and details, context clues and figurative language, analyzing characters, and summarizing.

Math

In May, we will continue with our geometry unit. Students will develop an understanding of angles and angle measurement. Students will measure and sketch angles and solve to find the unknown angle. We will also continue to focus on solving two step word problems involving the four operations. Towards the end of May, we will review all 4th grade concepts in preparation for the EOG.

Science/SS

Science

In 4th quarter, students will learn about the life in changing habitats. Students will understand the effects of environmental changes, adaptations and behaviors that enable animals to survive in changing environments. Students will be able to explain how animals meet their needs by using specific behaviors. Students will also be able to explain how differences among animals of the same population sometimes gives individuals an advantage to surviving and reproducing in changing habitats.
