Career & College Promise

Career & College Promise (CCP) allows high school students to take courses at Wake Technical Community College for free.

- Students can obtain dual enrollment credit - both college and high school credits for courses taken (UNC System Agreement)
- Way to access different courses that GLHS may not offer
- Obtain a technical skill/certificate
- Take general core courses for transfer to four year college/university

**Who is eligible
for CCP?**

9th & 10th Grade



Eligibility

- Students are expected to demonstrate academic giftedness.
 - In WCPSS, defined as being identified through the AIG program OR scoring 92-99th percentile on an approved standardized test
- Students must be ready for the coursework.
- Students must be mature enough to engage in college level work.

Eligibility

- Have an unweighted GPA of 2.8 or higher on high school courses
- Students must be ready for the coursework.

Dual Enrollment

9th and 10th stay on
campus for four

11th Grade



Dual Enrollment

11th (and 12th) can
have early release
- 3rd and 4th period
for CCP courses (50%)



Wake Tech

Recommend five courses
total per semester

Consider all are on the transcript

CCP & Your Transcript


- Your CCP course WILL show up on your GLHS transcript AND factor into your GPA.
- Your courses will also show on your future college transcript.
- For the most part, CTE courses are weighted like Honors courses and CT courses are weighted as AP courses but there are some exceptions.

Steps to Enrollment



Visit the CCP website for more details!

- Attend the MANDATORY information session offered by Wake Tech
- Talk to your counselor to see if CCP is right for you
- Submit application materials (requires approval from GLHS)
- Complete Orientation
- Register for classes
- Provide proof of enrollment to your counselor and schedule meeting to adjust schedule (if possible)
