# **Exam Information**

- All <u>teacher-made exams</u> will be administered during the corresponding class period.
   Teachers <u>DO</u> have the option of submitting a request for a class project to act as their exam.
- All <u>State-standardized exams</u> (EOC and CTE) will be administered <u>on campus</u> during the corresponding class period.
- State exams will be administered using WCPSS-issued Chromebooks. Students should bring them CHARGED and UPDATED to their exam. Students that do not have a Chromebook should request one from the Media Center as soon as possible.
- Students taking exams must be on time for each exam AND stay for the entire exam.
   Students MAY NOT check out during an exam.
- Students will take exams in their typical classroom unless otherwise specified by the classroom teacher.
- Students who are absent should reach out to their teacher to arrange a make-up exam.
   For state exams the test coordinator will schedule the make-up exam.
