## COLLFGFS

### ADMISSION

Open enrollment requires only your high school diploma. Your GPA or SAT/ACT scores are used to determine proper course placement, and competitive programs (Nursing, Dental Hygiene, etc.) may have additional admissions requirements.

PROGRAM OPTIONS

• Complete certificate(s), finish diploma or Associate Degree • College Transfer Program

AFFORDA-BILITY

Fulltime (12 credit) semester = Approx. \$1,200 per semester (approx. \$2400 per year)









## **4-YEAR UNIVERSITIES** PRIVATE COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES



The UNC-System hosts 16 universities that are funded by the state of North Carolina. Residents of NC are able to take advantage of in-state tuition which is significantly less than what out-of-state students pay.

Private and independent colleges sometimes have more flexible entrance requirements and vary widely. These colleges and universities are generally more expensive, however, they can sometimes offer more financial aid.



Students don't have to limit their search to colleges in NC. It is important to note that students attending out-of-state colleges and universities will be subject to out-of-state tuition fees at public universities.












The College Foundation of North Carolina houses an application portal for every community college and many of the 4-year colleges and universities through out the state.

Some colleges require students to submit LORs from teachers, counselors, and/or community members. Provide your recommender with a resume and/or <u>Brag Sheet</u>.

SAT/ACT - The UNC System has waived this requirement through Fall 2024. Check out-of-state and private colleges for test score policy.

Play a major role in admission decisions. Highlight student qualities/growth experiences that are not included anywhere else on the application.

NC <u>Residency Determination Service</u> (RDS) required for all NC colleges.


