Dear Counselor, Potential Applicant, or SAME Member,

The **Fort Bragg Post** of the Society of American Military Engineers (SAME) again has college scholarships it will award. The total scholarship fund for 2023 is estimated at **\$7,500.00**. Scholarships will be awarded to the most deserving applicants based on academic achievement, participation in extracurricular activities, and their desire to pursue an engineering-based degree in college.

The amount of the scholarship award will be based on the merits of the applicant. All awards are one-time awards. Past winners, and past applicants that meet the eligibility requirements are welcome to apply again for the scholarship.

The applicant must submit a completed application (via email) by **April 18, 2023**. To be eligible for a scholarship the applicant must meet the following requirements within an **engineering, architectural, science, or construction management** curriculum:

- (1) Be a **high school senior residing in North Carolina or having graduated from a high school in North Carolina** who has been accepted, or is planning to enroll, at an accredited college or university,

OR

Be a **current undergraduate student** at an accredited college or university in **North Carolina** with a baccalaureate degree program,

OR

Be a **current undergraduate student at a North Carolina** technical community college with an associate degree program, after which the student plans to transfer to a four-year school with an engineering, architectural, or construction management curriculum.

- (2) Have a **minimum** of a B average (3.0 on 4.0 scale), whether high school or college.
- (3) Provide a **completed application** form with **all** required supporting information.

After selections have been made, winning individuals will be contacted by the Scholarship Committee. The winners will be presented their scholarship checks at the **May 23, 2022** membership luncheon meeting of the Fort Bragg SAME Post.
