Positivity Project - Social Intelligence and Optimism

Dear Families.

This week our Track 3 students will be focusing on the character strength of Social Intelligence. Social intelligence means you are aware of other people's thoughts and feelings. You understand why they do things.

Social intelligence refers to a person's ability to understand and manage interpersonal relationships. It is distinct from a person's IQ or "book smarts." It includes an individual's ability to understand, and act on, the feelings, thoughts, and behaviors of other people. This type of intelligence can take place "in the moment" of face-to-face conversations but also appears during times of deliberate thinking. It involves emotional intelligence and self-awareness.

Social intelligence helps individuals build relationships — and is important to numerous aspects of a person's life. It allows an individual to form friendships and alliances. And it assists a person against being taken advantage of. People with social intelligence can "read" other people's faces and know what motivates them. Social intelligence builds over time and as a person ages. In this sense, it is similar to the character strength of perspective.

To practice and encourage the character strength of social intelligence with your child, please visit the Positivity Project's <u>P2 for Families</u> (password: **P2**), where together you will watch a video, read a quote, and talk about the answers to three questions.

This week our Track 4 students will be focusing on the character strength of Optimism. Optimism means you expect the best from the future and work to achieve it.

Optimism represents a state of hopefulness and confidence about the future (both short and long term). People with this strength are future-oriented. They have a positive vision of what the future holds and maintain confidence that they will get there. Despite setbacks, they keep a positive attitude and often find ways to convert what seems like an obstacle into a stepping-stone to achieving their goals.

Optimism is not about wearing rose-colored glasses and rolling over when the going gets tough. It's about staying focused on the good in any situation -- allowing you to be aware of opportunities and accountable for your emotions. Optimists are strong leaders. They find meaning in hardship and can create a vision for the future. Optimists are inspiring; their example is contagious. And, by sharing and achieving their vision -- despite setbacks -- they help us all achieve more.

EOG Testing Info/Tips - Did you know about the NC Standard Course of Study?

Lessons each day in your student's classes are created from the standards in the NC Standard Course of Study. This prepares them for their EOGs and EOCs at the end of the school year that become part of their permanent school record.

Therefore, it is imperative students demonstrate their learning in class and on assessments so teachers can modify the instruction. All staff reviews students' assessment data (i.e.- Classroom assessments, FastBridge assessments, STAR Math, Delta Math, Formative, etc...) to determine students' levels of learning. Instruction and pacing is determined on student learning.


