I want to remind folks to ONLY drop off students in the carpool loop or at the top of Rowan where the crossing guard is located. Many parents continue to drop kids off in front of the school and have them cross traffic. This is not safe. The safety of our students is a priority. Please be a part of the solution.

Also, EMS has been on our campus several times over the last 2-3 weeks. Every incident has been related to a medical emergency with a student or staff member. Many parents have reached out regarding EMS being on campus because they heard that a student was injured due to fighting. This is not true. EMS has been called only for medical emergencies for students related to health reasons. Should EMS ever be called due to a fight on campus, you will immediately receive communication directly from me. Episodes of fighting continue to decline at CMMS.
