Spring Athletic Information (Boys Soccer, Girls/Boys Track, and Softball) Tryouts will be the week of February 27th. Coaches will have information sessions before to provide details. To be eligible to try out all participants need to do the following PRIOR to tryouts.

- All registration materials, including physicals and doctor approval forms, must be signed and completed in <u>Dragonfly</u> **BEFORE** tryouts start. This is a lengthy process. Please make appointments for physicals now.
- Attendance checked for Semester 1, no more than 14 absences
- Passing 3 out of 4 core classes in Semester 1
- Students will get a "Ticket to Play" from the Athletic Director or Coach before participating. This is required to tryout.
- There is an Appeals Process if a student is not eligible to participate due to attendance or grades. Email Battle Watkins if you have questions <u>cwatkins@wcpss.net</u>. The appeal needs to be completed PRIOR to trying out.
