Greetings Carroll Families,

Don't forget to order your student's yearbook! Books are \$30 online and \$35 in person. Online orders will close on May 20. Visit www.yearbookordercenter.com and use code 15145 to order today.

EOG/EOCs will be given on May 31st, June 1st, and June 2nd. Please try to have your child at school on time on these days so that we may begin testing promptly. **Students will be expected to bring their charged Chromebook to school on testing days.**

Any student who does not pass the EOG for ELA, Math, or 8th Science, will have the opportunity to retest on June 12th (ELA) and June 13th (6/7th Math & 8th Science). If your child is a bus rider, transportation will be provided. Also, breakfast and lunch will be provided on these dates as well. You will receive a letter home for an invitation to retest IF your child will retest. We ask that you let us know if your child will retest by returning the form the following day.

On Tuesday, June 6th your child will bring home an **EOG/EOC Score Reports** and a **Math Placement Recommendation Form** for 6th and 7th graders. We would like you to review the recommendation and either confirm the recommendation or suggest an alternative. We ask that your return this form with your child the next day. If you would like to discuss the placement, please share this information on the form.

There will be a Summer Band Concert on Thursday, May 25th in the auditorium at Carroll. 6th Grade students will perform at 6 pm. 7th and 8th grade students will perform at 7pm. Everyone is welcome to attend. Bring a friend.
