Frequently Asked Questions

Question	Answer
1. Will there be an in person ceremony?	Yes. The in person ceremony will be held at Wendell Middle School in the gymnasium. The event is scheduled for June 9th at the following times: First Ceremony Session - Lobos Team 8:45am Second Ceremony Session - Mackenzie Team 10:45am Third Ceremony Session- Gray Wolves, Dream Team, & Virtual Academy 12:45pm
2. How long will it last?	It is estimated that the ceremony will be about 45 minutes long.
3. Is there a limit to how many people can attend?	Yes. We really want families to be able to celebrate this occasion with their child. However, due to capacity guidelines, we must limit the event to six tickets per family. Children under five will not require a ticket.
4. How do I get tickets for the event?	Tickets will be sent home with your child at least one week before the event. A talking points message will be sent out before sending the tickets home.
5. Will we need to wear a mask?	Masks are optional.
6. Does my child need to dress up for the ceremony?	We want to encourage your child to dress up for the event, however it is not mandatory. Please adhere to WMS dress code policy.
7. Are we allowed to cheer for our child?	Out of respect for all of our students, please hold your applause until the end. Family and friends will be given an opportunity to cheer after all names are called.
8. Where do we park?	Please use the parking lot in the front of the building and enter through the front doors.
9. What happens if I lose my tickets?	Unfortunately, we are unable to replace lost tickets.
