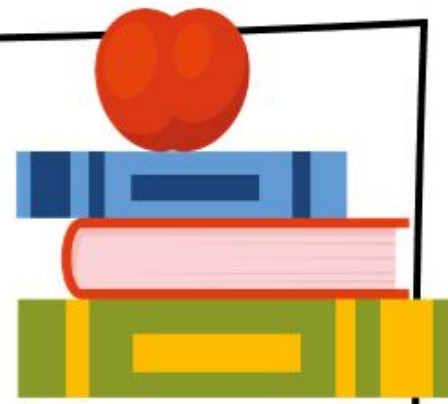


OUR CLASSROOM newsletter

WEEKLY REMINDERS:

OUR LEARNING SNAPSHOT:

LANGUAGE ARTS:

- We will begin to discuss fiction texts through interactive read alouds. Students will engage in speaking, language, & writing experiences to learn characters, setting and events of a story.

LETTERLAND:

- Beginning this week, students will receive a list of words to practice at home. We will have a written quiz on the words each Friday. Our first word list will focus on *short a* words.

MATH:

- We will practice counting, writing numbers, and organizing data in charts (beginning graphing skills).

SOCIAL STUDIES:

- We will begin the year by focusing on learning about the importance of rules & procedures, as well as building our classroom community.

REMINDERS:

- Please be sure to send a water bottle with your child each day.

HOMEWORK FOLDERS:
