Academic Updates

As you perhaps have heard, this year the North Carolina Department of Public Instruction (NCDPI) has transitioned from using MCLASS to adopting Istation as the program for measuring reading skills. Jeffreys Grove will continue to monitor our students' ongoing reading progress as we begin to use the Istation's Indicators of Progress (ISIP) assessment in January, 2020. <u>Here</u> is the official parent letter released by WCPSS and NCDPI.
