#### **READvolution**

There has been an update to the time frame for the READvolution campaign which will now go on until Friday, December 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Students can record the titles of every book they read by logging into their WakeID portal. You can find detailed instructions <u>HERE</u>. Along with digitally logging their minutes students will also be able to write their names on paper "pucks." These "pucks" will be added to our school's Hurricanes hockey goal banner. Our goal is to collectively fill the banner with 2,020 pucks.

I know you are excited to hear about how we are doing as a school. As of November 1st, we have read a total of 1,233 books. That is a total of 70,835 minutes.

This is a good start to creating GREAT reading habits. The experience of reading (whether you're the reader or the one being read to) activates and "exercises" many areas of the brain. For our kindergarten friends, remember that being read to helps children develop good listening skills by keying them into the components of the language. So this time can also count towards READvolution. Through reading, students can learn to recognize phonemes (the sound building blocks of the language), learn new words to add to their oral vocabulary and connect written words to real world applications. Generally, the more time one is exposed to something and the more time spent practicing, the better one becomes at doing it.
