Her hair is long and braided; she has worn it that way all her life and could probably braid it in her sleep. It is covered by a white cap with a narrow pleat going from front to back...Rebecca's ancestors wore simple forms of European clothes popular when the sect began in the seventeenth century. Not until two hundred years later did Amish leaders begin to enforce traditional clothing. Now dressing in proper Amish style is part of the *Ordnung*, the set of rules that governs their behavior.

Popcorn Fundraiser

The seventh grade at George Middle School is planning to sell popcorn at the football games. They want to buy the brand of popcorn that will yield the most cooked popcorn. They need to decide between the following brands and make a recommendation to the class sponsor (who also happens to be the math teacher!)

- Brand A: 1 cup uncooked popcorn yields 5 cups cooked popcorn
- Brand B: 4 cups uncooked popcorn yields 25 cups cooked popcorn
- Brand C: 3 cups uncooked popcorn yields 10 cups cooked popcorn
- Brand D: 5 cups uncooked popcorn yields 20 cups cooked popcorn

Your Task:

Using the information, write a letter to the class sponsor with the recommendation for the brand of popcorn to purchase. Include the following information:

- The brand(s) which will give you the best ratio of uncooked popcorn to cooked popcorn,
- An explanation of the reason behind your recommendation, and
- An explanation of the math you used to solve the problem.

1. Did you detect any biases (unfair preference or dislike) regarding Amish style?
