***\*\* If you are interested in purchasing a Chromebook for your student to use at home, this is the current recommended specifications: 32GB, SSD drive, 4GB Ram (minimum), 11" Touchscreen. Several manufacturers make Chromebooks with those specs at a reasonable cost. You can use this information as a guide for the minimum requirements for any device you might choose to purchase. We do not recommend iPads.***

The following is a list of **essential supplies** that all students will need this school year. We appreciate you following this list as closely as possible. ***Please do not pre-label notebooks and folders with names or subjects.***

- **Math**
  - 1.5 inch view binder with plastic sleeve on the front
  - 1 pack of tab dividers **with pockets** (5 tabs)
  - 1 **CLEAR** Protractor
  - 1 pack- wide ruled loose leaf notebook paper
- **ELA**
  - 2 packs- wide ruled loose leaf notebook paper
  - 2 composition notebooks
  - 2- **plastic** pocket folder **with prongs** on the inside
  - Post-It notes
- **Science**
  - 1 composition notebook
- **Social Studies**
  - 1- **plastic** pocket folder **with prongs** on the inside
- **Misc.**
  - 2- **plastic** pocket folders **with prongs** on the inside (Classwork/Homework)
  - 1- **plastic** pocket folder **with prongs** on the inside (Homework)
  - 2 composition notebooks (1 for Morning Work, 1 for Music)
  - 1 pair of round-tip scissors
  - 1- fabric pencil pouch
  - Ticonderoga #2 pencils-pre-sharpened if possible! (no mechanical pencils or pencil sharpeners, please!)
  - 1 box of crayons; 1 box of colored pencils
  - 1 pack- fine point dry erase markers
  - 1- set of earbuds for personal use
  - 2 box of tissues
  - 12 glue sticks
  - Box of pencil top erasers

The following supplies will be available for use by all students in the classroom. If you would like to **donate** any of the supplies listed below, we would be very grateful.
