Apex Friendship High School Neighbors, Students, and Parents:

Recently an issue has come up concerning students parking their vehicles on residential properties surrounding Apex Friendship High School. This practice is not permitted by the Town of Apex Unified Development Ordinance. It is prohibited for residential property owners to allow vehicles to be parked on their property, with or without the payment of a fee. If you are planning to enter an agreement with a neighboring residential property owner, or if you already are, please be advised that the ordinance will be strictly enforced beginning in August.

Student parking (whether paid or free) is not allowed on residential properties and civil penalties of \$100 per day (or a one-time penalty of \$500) can be assessed on the property owner for allowing students to park on their property.
