



Apex Friendship High School PSAT Registration 2019

Test date: Wednesday, October 16, 2019 • 7:45 a.m.

The PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) will be administered at Apex Friendship on Wednesday, October 16, at 7:45 a.m. Registration is open September 4 through September 16.

The PSAT is a standardized, multiple-choice test that includes three sections: critical reading, mathematics, and writing. The test provides practice for the SAT. Students who take the PSAT/NMSQT are automatically screened for the National Merit® Scholarship Program, an academic competition for recognition and scholarships.

WCPSS will offer the test free of charge to AFHS juniors who have a weighted GPA of 4.3125 or higher. These students will be contacted directly during the first week of school. All other students will pay a \$17 fee to take the exam.

WCPSS students can pay through Online School Payment* or in Student Services with **exact cash** or a **check made out to AFHS** (before or after school, during STAR lunch). Other students can pay with exact cash or check in the Student Services reception area of Apex Friendship between 7:30 and 3:00. Fee waivers are available for students based on financial need. **All students testing must complete the form below and submit it, along with payment or receipt of payment, to Student Services.**

*Payment can be made by clicking the "ONLINE PAYMENTS" tab on the AFHS website and selecting PSAT Registration. Please print and attach your receipt to this completed registration form and submit to Student Services.

(The PreACT will be administered free of charge to all WCPSS sophomores during the school day in November.)
