EXAM NOTES

General Information for All Exams

- All administrations of <u>EOC and CTE assessments</u> must be in person as required by state policy.
- Room assignments will be posted on the AFHS website the week prior to exams.
- While exceptionally rare, there are limited situations that require an adjustment to a student's exam schedule. To request an adjustment, the <u>AFHS form</u> must be completed and returned to the Testing Coordinator (Mrs. Matthews) no later than May 22, 2026.
- We are committed to providing students with an environment conducive to all students doing their best on exams. As a result, students will not be permitted to check out early during exam blocks. Please schedule appointments, etc. accordingly.
- June 11th is intended for make-up exams. Only students who missed an exam must report to campus this day. Bus routes will only run on this date where we know that a student is planning to attend and has let us know that they intended to utilize their normal WCPSS Bus Transportation.

For June 11 & 12 EOC Exams

- Students taking an EOC exam on June 9 & 10 are required to report to class on June 5 & 8 during their class period for exam review sessions.
- Students who remain on campus after the EOC and/or make-up exam periods will participate in a study hall.
 Those choosing early departure after exams are expected to submit an early departure form to their EOC teacher(s).
- Only students who are scheduled to take EOC exams on that day are required to report to school on June 9 & 10. Any other students who report to school will be in a study hall from 7:25 am-2:18 pm.
- If absent from an exam, a student must submit a parent note to the Attendance Office upon return to school.
 The student is responsible for working with the teacher to schedule the make-up exam for a teacher-made exam. For a state exam, the test coordinator for state exams will schedule the make-up state exam.
- Per Board Policy, seniors are not eligible for exemption from exams for courses with state testing requirements (EOC and CTE post assessments).
