If enrollment numbers in VA are high, can Plan B students come back as a single group or more frequent than 3-week rotations?

There have not been any discussions to deviate from the original plan of three groups.

Will Plan B TRANSITION continue to have 3 week rotating sessions - 1 week in school, 2 weeks remote?

No, all students will learn remotely under Plan B Transition.

Will there be HOT Lunch? Will Juniors and Seniors be allowed to leave campus for lunch?

We will not have a 55 minute lunch in the current climate. No decision has been made on allowing students to leave campus for lunch when we have students in the building.

Does enrollment in VA impact class rank in any way?

Enrollment in VA will not impact class rank.

Does enrollment in VA impact my ability to participate in clubs like Robotics, Marching Band, TriM Honor Society, etc?

No, but at this time all extra-curricular activities are suspended.

Does enrollment in VA impact my ability to take classes in the Arts (Band, Chorus, Theater, Dance) with HSHS teachers?

No, we are planning to offer these classes in both options.

Does enrollment in VA impact my role in a club as an officer?

No.

If I am following Plan B, can I switch to 100% remote learning if I am not comfortable coming to class in person?

If you feel you may become uncomfortable with your child coming to campus during the 1st semester you should enroll in the Virtual Academy within the window of July 27-29.

What is the commitment for VA?

Families must commit for at least one full semester of learning within the VA. There will be a window late in the fall semester to sign up for VA for the spring semester if the family did not choose year-long VA this summer.

Will all HSHS classes be offered in Plan B?

That is still being determined, we are hoping to offer all of our classes in Plan B.

Will all HSHS classes be offered in Virtual Academy?

That is still being determined, we are hoping to offer all of our classes in VA.

How will the Class of 2021 be celebrated? Will students enrolled in VA be able to participate?

We will work to celebrate the Class of 2021 in the same time frame and manner as allowed by state social distancing guidelines. Enrollment in VA will not impact a student's ability to participate in extracurricular activities or celebrations.

During this time, can students reach out to teachers for college application guidance or for letters of recommendation?

Yes.

Will there be college admission, college open house or FAFSA presentations offered virtually?

Yes.

Will attendance be taken in all remote/online classes?

Attendance will be taken daily in all classes.

How will athletics be structured?

Right now, athletics are suspended indefinitely.
