Exam Schedule Information:

- Students will take all teacher made, End of Course, and CTE Exams in person during their scheduled exam block. Students must remain in their classrooms for the duration of the exam block in order to maintain the integrity of all assessments and provide optimum opportunity for success for all students, **students will NOT be permitted to check out early during the exam block.**
- The exam block will end around 11:00 am each day and all students may leave campus at that time. Students who do not leave campus at dismissal time will remain in the commons area until the buses leave at 2:18 pm for a study hall.
- Students who arrive late to school on the day of the exam will not be allowed to test. They will need to attend a make-up session on January 14th.
- A grab and go breakfast and lunch will be provided for all students on exam days.
- Exams will count as 20 percent of the student's final grade. Exam scores will be averaged into the final grade. The exam grade will impact the final course average either positively or negatively depending on the student's grades.
- For the 2021-2022 school year, students in Grade 12 only may be exempt from teacher made exams only based on a projected final course average of C or higher are eligible to be exempt. Absences will not be considered in determining exemption status for the 2021-2022 school year. The principal has final authority to determine a student's exemption status.
