Exam Schedule Information:

State Exams

EOC Exams: Math 1, Math 3, English 2, and Biology

CTE Exams: Child Development, Principles of Family & Human Services, Principles of Business & Finance, Business Law, Fashion Merchandising, Foods 1, Foods 2, Sports Marketing 1, Sports Marketing 2, Foundations of Health Science, Health Science 1

- All state exams must be given in person as required by the state of NC for all students.
- Students will be testing in groups of 15 students or less.
- Students will have the opportunity to complete a medical exemption from testing form to document medical or safety concerns with reporting to campus. Please contact Tamara Young, contact information is below.
- Students who do not test and do not submit a medical exemption request will receive an incomplete until such time as they test and/or the district receives further guidance from the state.
- WCPSS will provide transportation for those who are participating in on campus testing. Ample parking is available for any student that chooses to drive to campus.
- Students will be required to complete a health screening when arriving on campus and will be required to wear a mask while testing.
- Students will be allowed to leave campus once the testing session has ended in their classroom.
- If a student's score on the state exam is lower than the combined average of Quarter 1 and Quarter 2, the student's exam score will be curved to equal their course average. It is important to note that the score is curved for the purpose of calculating the course average. The original EOC scale score, achievement level, and percentile will be reflected on the student transcript.

Teacher Made Exam

All teacher made exams will be given virtually. They will be distributed by teachers on January 4th and will be due by Wednesday, January 13th at 5:00 pm. The teacher made exam may be similar to past exams or a project based on the needs of the class. All teacher-made exams will count for 20% of the students final grade and will be counted only if it raises the students final grade for the course. If a student does not take the final exam or their final exam grade does not improve their final grade each quarter will count as 50% when calculating the final grade. **AP classes have the option of giving a Virtual Final Exam during exam week.**
