COUGAR Students and Parents:

Welcome to the 2019-2020 school year at Zebulon Gifted & Talented Magnet Middle School (ZGTMMS)! We are excited about the coming year and we are looking forward to working with you! We want to make sure you are aware of some important information and dates. We will host our 6th Grade "Cougar Camp" for our 6th grade students August 22 8:30am-12:30pm. Middle school offers many new challenges for students coming from elementary school so we offer this opportunity for students to spend time acclimating themselves to our school. We will also host our 6th, 7th, and 8th Grade "Meet the Teacher" for parents and students August 22 12:30pm-6:30pm. This event will give students and parents the opportunity to visit the Parent Resource Center and meet your teachers in order to create connections, build open communication, and share expectations for the school year. All beginning of the year forms enclosed should be completed prior to August 22, 2019.

6th Grade COUGAR CAMP August 22 8:30am-12:30pm (Students ONLY)

During this time students will get the opportunity to meet administration, their teachers, counselors, and receive vital information that will guide them through the first day and beyond. We want students to feel comfortable in their new surroundings while creating new friendships. Our Cougar Camp gives teachers the opportunity to address normal back-to-school formalities that help focus on learning. There is no fee for this camp and lunch will be provided for students. Parent/guardian with the student can retrieve the student schedule at a registration table located at the entrance of the grade level building. We ask that you turn in the beginning of the year forms completed and signed. Parents and students will follow the student schedule to meet their teachers. ZGTMMS FAQ GENERAL SCHOOL INFORMATION 2019-2020

Arrival and Dismissal:

School hours are from 8:15am until 3:00pm. A copy of the ZGTMMS bell schedule is posted on the website along with other school information at <u>www.wcpss.net/zebulonms</u>. Students are not allowed to be dropped off on campus prior to 7:45am and must be picked up from school no later than 3:30pm.

Bus Transportation:

The south parking lot (in front of the gymnasium) is the bus arrival and dismissal area. Therefore, it will not be open to school traffic from 7:45am until 8:15am in the morning and from 2:30pm until 3:30pm in the afternoon. The bus transportation area is located in the front of the building and should not be impeded due to pedestrian or car traffic. To register for bus transportation, please log onto <u>http://www.wcpss.net/busrider</u>. **Here Comes the Bus** translates GPS data into an easy to use customizable map that works on a computer, tablet or smartphone. The app allows you to see where the bus is and how close it is to your stop. Get started with **Here Comes the Bus** at <u>https://herecomesthebus.com/getting-started/</u>. You will need the district code and your student's ID number to sign up. The WCPSS school code is 67500. For your smartphone or tablet, download the **Here Comes the Bus** app from the <u>App Store</u> or <u>Google Play</u>. Car Transportation:

If you drive your child to school, you should utilize the parking lot for drop-off and pick-up located in the back of the school building. Students will not be allowed to cross the street for parent pick-up. Please follow all traffic patterns to maintain safety while on campus. Please do not drive between buses or cut in front of buses. During the times of **7:45-8:15 and 2:30-3:30 cars should not enter or exit through the front parking lot driveway, parking lot, or any other area that the buses will utilize.**

Cafeteria:

Meals may be purchased in person. However, you may also purchase meals online. With a MySchool Bucks account paying for school meals is easy. Go to <u>www.MySchoolBucks.com</u> or call (855) 832-5226 to enroll. You'll need your child's NCWISE ID number. Once your account is established you may: Securely deposit funds to your child's account, Check balances, Set spending limits. To apply for free or reduced-price meals, you need to complete an original application packet, which is mailed to all households with registered students in Wake County public schools and is also available at your school. Early Check-Out:

If it is necessary for a student to leave school during the day, the parent/guardian must sign the student out in the office before he/she may leave campus. If the student returns to complete the school day, he/she must report to the office and be signed back in with the parent/guardian before returning to class. All requests for transportation changes must be completed prior to 2:30pm. ALL CHECK-OUTS should be completed prior to 2:30pm.

Immunizations REQUIRED:

The North Carolina General Statutes (G.S. 130A-155) requires immunizations for every child attending public school in this state. Every parent or guardian is responsible for ensuring that their child(ren) receive required immunizations. The T-dap and the Meningococcal vaccine are requirements for ALL 7th graders.

Medications:

School staff may administer medication to students only when the Parent and Physician Order for Medication form (Form 1702) is completed by the parent and physician and present at the school. Parent Teacher Conferences:

Please contact your child's teachers in order to set up parent teacher conferences. You may also reach out to our counselors to assist you in that process. PTC's will be held throughout the year. We have also designated three days for the school year once report cards are sent home for additional times to meet with teachers. Those dates are below and located on our school calendar.

Powerschool/Homebase:

Home Base gives parents and students access to real-time information including attendance, grades and assignments. With Home Base, powered by PowerSchool application, everyone stays connected: Students stay on top of assignments, parents are able to participate in their child's progress, and teachers can instantly share information from their gradebook
