Caps & Gowns

Jostens will be on campus for a make-up delivery day on Friday, April 28 in the cafeteria during lunch to deliver caps and gowns as well as senior products. All items must be paid in full before students can receive their products. Online payments must be made 24 hours prior to the delivery date. Senior Awards Day

Senior Awards Day is on Friday, May 26 and will start at 8am. Seniors must arrive by 7am. Students will dress as they will for graduation including their caps and gowns. All student names will be called at this event. Invitations will be sent to the parents of students who are being specifically celebrated for awards, scholarships, etc. This event is typically about two hours. Parents are invited to attend. Graduation Rehearsal

Graduation rehearsal is at 6pm at the Raleigh Convention Center (RCC) on Monday, June 5. Seniors must arrive by 5:30pm. It is during this event that students will walk through the logistics of graduation. Dress is casual and students do not need their caps and gowns for this event. Students should plan on heavy traffic going to this event and should expect to pay for parking. They will receive guest tickets at this event. If a student does not attend graduation rehearsal, they will not be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.

Graduation Ceremony

Graduation will be at 4pm on Sunday, June 11. Students must arrive at the RCC by 3pm. Student dress code must be met of either: (1) dark pants and shoes, dress shirt with tie or (2) dress that does not extend beyond the hem of the graduation gown. Graduation caps / gowns cannot be decorated in any way. Anticipate that the graduation will last about 60 minutes.

Please keep the following in mind with regard to the graduation ceremony:

- Each student will receive 9 tickets to graduation. There are no additional tickets to request.
- All individuals require a ticket including infants / babies. This is an RCC rule, not an HSHS rule.
- Many items are prohibited by RCC including flowers, food, drink, wrapped packages, camera bags, etc.
- Students must clear all fines, fees, and obligations to the school to be permitted to participate in the graduation ceremony.
- Graduation will be live streamed so that those who cannot attend can view the graduation.
- A photographer will take photos of the students as they cross the stage. Details on ordering those photos is forthcoming.

Senior Exam Exemptions

I shared with seniors that a process would be forthcoming to request that a very small number of absences be waived above the limit for exam exemptions for absences specifically and narrowly related to the mission of the school (ex: if a senior were to attend a scholarship interview for which they do not have control of the time).
