During the first few days of school, we have been working diligently along with our School Resource Officers to re our afternoon dismissal procedures to ensure that our dismissal process for carpool and student drivers is both efficient and safe. Our goal is to get all drivers off of the campus as quickly as possible while still maintaining safe routes. As a part of that process, we have seen several near accidents when drivers (parents and students) are turning left out of the main entrance onto Cass Holt Road. As a result, we have attempted over the last two days to require all drivers to turn right to see if that would provide a safer situation. In short - it did.

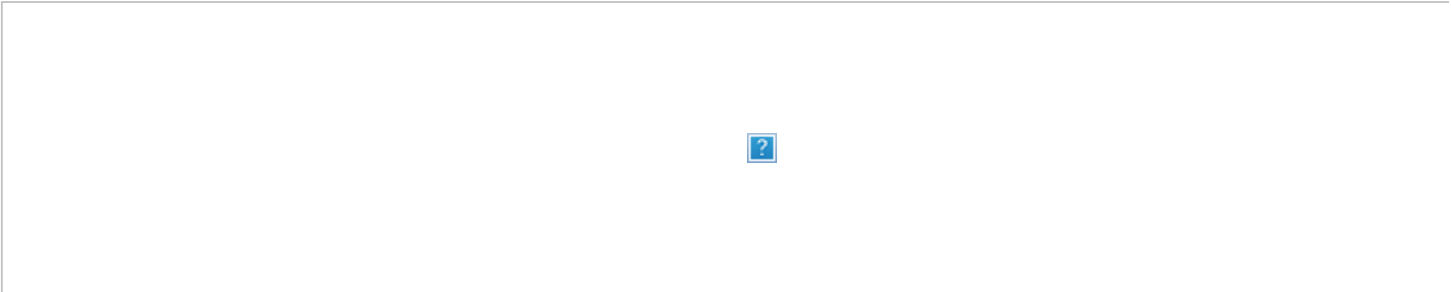
Starting immediately, we will put up cones in the afternoon to require drivers to turn right only coming out of the entrance onto Cass Holt Road between 2:18 - 2:30pm.
