

### Senior Support Day - December 15 SENIORS MUST SIGN UP BY TUESDAY, DECEMBER 13 TO PARTICIPATE.

With the year moving quickly toward winter break, we want to provide seniors with an opportunity to get some help with finalizing college applications, submitting scholarship applications, and more. On December 15, we will have counselors and others in the media center throughout the day to help students with their applications, provide feedback on essays that need to be submitted, etc. Seniors can sign up to go to the media center on December 15 during either 1st & 2nd period or 3rd & 4th period to receive this support. They will NOT be marked absent and attending will have NO impact on senior exam exemptions.

In order to sign up, students must see their counselor. Students will have to commit to a plan for their work that includes completing three specific things while in the media center -- at least one of those must be submitting a scholarship application. Students who have already completed college applications are also welcome to attend and work on three scholarships.
