**Important Reminder:** If you have made arrangements with another parent to pick their child up from school, **please make sure you communicate with the child's teacher or the front office before you leave campus with that child.** Please do not assume that the teacher saw you take the child. Several times this year, we have experienced miscommunication between the parents and the individuals picking up the children. When the teacher or office is not notified, this creates a situation in which we do not know who has the child. Many times the parent, who made the arrangement, is unavailable to be reached by phone. This causes a tremendous level of stress for all parties. Each time this has occurred, the child is safe with a family member or friend, but better communication with the school would prevent these issues. Parents are reminded that if a child is to go home with someone else or use different method of transportation, you should always **send a note to the teacher** so they are aware and can help your child remember the change in their transportation for the day.
