PreK - 3 PLAN B FAMILIES PLEASE READ

WCPSS has developed accountability protocols and these must be reviewed by everyone. Faculty and staff members have been asked to verify they understand their role and now we ask the same of our JGMES parents, guardians, and students.

Thank you for doing your part to make this upcoming return possible and sustaining it until returning to school at full capacity is possible.

Submit the following forms before Monday, November 13th to our Child' teacher:

- 1. All students are required to submit a one time student accountability form. Student Accountability and Required Health Protocols English: <u>https://rb.gy/jqrinu</u>
- Bus Riders Only: All bus riders are required to submit the one-time attestation form. <u>Bus Attestation Form</u> (<u>https://www.wcpss.net/busform</u>) You will be receiving a paper copy in your student material bags with your bus tags. 3. **BYOD (Bring Your Own Device**): If your child brings a personal device to school they will receive a BYOD consent form to be completed and return to the classroom teacher by the end of the in-person week. <u>English</u>

- If you are not a base family you must apply for our immersion program by completing a magnet application on the WCPSS website <u>Magnet Schools / Application Process</u> which closes on January 28, 2021
- Middle School Pathway If you would like your 5th grade student to continue to Spanish Immersion program at Oberlin Middle and Oberlin is not your base, you must go online and submit a magnet application <u>Magnet Schools / Application Process</u> which closes on January 15,2021. There is no automatic assignment. Students that do not apply will be assigned to their base middle school.
