

Advocacy

This past Thursday, PTA President Cheri Thomas and I attended the District 7 BAC (Board Advisory Council) monthly meeting. (These meetings are open to all and cover a range of topics, from student assignment to academics and community resilience.) The topic this month was **Curriculum**, and Dr. MIller, Director of K-12 Literacy, was the guest speaker.



Dr. Mller reviewed the timeline and process our district followed leading up to the adoption of our current ELA (English Language Arts) curriculum resources: EL. The process was not a quick one, and it involved field testing and input from parents, educators and the community. We learned that EL rose to the top because it has the highest ratings, and it is used by over 500 school districts for its text complexity, diverse perspectives and scaffolds for learning.

What does this mean for my child in the classroom? - "Mastery of knowledge and skills", "character education", and "high quality student work", are at the center of the EL lessons we teach in our classrooms everyday. The year is divided into 4 modules; each module has 3 units. Each unit begins with building background knowledge, which then develops extended reading and research, and concludes with extended writing. You'll see students reading, thinking, talking and then writing, using a variety of protocols that promote active student discussions. The EL curriculum also comes with built-in assessments and multiple opportunities for students to show their learning in a variety of ways (not just multiple choice testing).

How can I support my child at home? - On our Jeffreys Grove website, under the Parents tab, we invite you to visit the "<u>Homework Resources</u>". Here you'll find module highlights organized by grade level in English and Spanish.

Our next BAC meeting is scheduled for February 6 at 6:30pm at Hilburn Academy. The topic will be **Community Resilience and Social/Emotional Learning**. We hope you'll join us!
