Each student will receive a bag including all of their instructional material for the first 9 weeks. On the assigned day (AM/PM), families will come through the bus loop to pick up their bag. Our teachers will distribute bags to families using proper social distancing protocols and PPE. We ask that families remain in their vehicle at all times.

Chromebooks & Hotspots

The district is coordinating the distribution of Chromebooks and hotspots; if you requested a Chromebook or hotspot, you will follow the plan for technology distribution outlined by our district. On Friday, August 7th, you should have received communication from the district outlining student device distribution, which will begin on August 17 and will continue until all students have their devices. Families that requested devices will receive an email from the district Technology Services Division (not Jeffreys Grove) three days prior to when your devices will be ready for pick up. You will be able to pick up the devices on your assigned day or any day after.

What does the PTA do?

Though this year will be different from past years, the JG PTA will continue to keep you informed; advocate for our students and staff; organize Staff Appreciation events throughout the year; fund Cultural Arts events, provide Creative Teaching Grants (funding for Teaching materials that aren't provided by the district, or online subscriptions not generally offered); support Staff Development; and Special Projects - this year we are hoping to fund technology upgrades.



Last year the PTA provided the following:

Scholastic Magazine, MobyMax, RazKids; free FunRun shirts to all students and staff; \$15,000 worth of books for the Library; over \$11,000 worth of Audio Visual equipment for the multipurpose room; sponsored 1 teacher to attend a Wilson Method training; organized a food drive when school closed unexpectedly; and so much more.
