PTA Business

The PTA Board voted Thursday, May 21st, to postpone 2020-2021 Board Elections. We will vote at the first General Membership meeting. The proposed slate is as follows:

End of Year Treasurer's Report:

We are still working on the 2020-2021 budget and will share that with you at the first General Membership Meeting. At this time we have approximately \$650 left in the account that can be spent. (Note: Per the 2019-2020 budget, \$11,000 is to remain in the account in case of emergency. The \$650 referenced is the current amount available to spend on approved expenses for 2019-2020).

Canceling Silent Auction/Parents Night Out, Festival, the in house Book Fair, and limiting Silver Graphics orders to online only, resulted in approximately \$30,000 in lost income for this year.

The Board has agreed to push forward approximately \$18,000 for library books (These monies were raised during Fun Run for the purchase of new library books. Mrs. White, the Media Specialist, was in the process of placing the order when the building was shut down; the order has been pushed to next fiscal year, starting July 1.) The PTA General Membership had already voted to apply Fun Run money to the purchase of library books. Let us know if you are opposed to this.

Silver Graphics generally generates \$1800-\$2000 for Specials (Art, Music, PE); at this point we have only raised approximately \$830. Silver Graphics is extending our purchase date through July 31st. This money will not be received before July 1.

We are still waiting on final numbers from Book Fair, but we raised \$700 the first week. Scholastics is also extending our fundraiser through the summer. This money will not be received before July 1.

Yearbook generated a profit of \$101 but this money will not be received until after July 1; Signs generated a profit of approximately \$431; Alicia DVD's netted a loss of approximately \$1,150 - we are working to recoup some of this cost from the Videographer.


