From the desk of... **Principal Ventura**

Dear JG Families:



I hope you're doing well and settling into the rhythm of being back in school. Please mark your calendars for an important event this month. We are excited to host our Virtual Open House on Wednesday, September 30th. Kindergarten through 2nd grade teachers will present at 5:30 pm and Grades 3-5 at 6:30 pm. To help families with multiple children who may experience a time conflict, we have staggered the start times. However, we realize that for some families it may still be difficult to attend. Please know that teachers will be recording their session and sharing this with their families as well.

Prior to our Virtual Open House, we will be launching a **parent survey** to gather information that will help us address questions on September 30th. It is important that you participate in the survey so that we can address ways in which we can further support you. The survey will be launched the week of September 21st and you will receive a survey link from your child's teacher.

On the week of September 21st parents should expect interim reports to go out via email. Please make sure your child's teacher has a current email address for you. If you do not receive an email by Friday, September 25th with your child interim progress report attached, please reach out to your child's teacher. If you have any questions regarding the content of the report, please know your child's teacher is always available.

Finally, a few parents have asked for suggestions around **screen time**. As a parent you know your child's tolerance level and needs. Please continue to encourage your child to take breaks where needed and share this with your teacher. **If your child is completing a slide online, consider going analog.** It is perfectly fine for your child to write on a piece of paper and turn in his/her assignment as a pdf or image; this can be done by taking a picture of their work and emailing it to their teacher or uploading it to their Google classroom. Additionally, talk to your child's teacher about completing independent work later in the day if you feel your child would benefit from a screen break. Stepping away from the screen and getting some physical activity can not only reset our attention but also ensure we are moving our bodies and not sitting constantly.
