I've had a few people ask me "Why don't we see as many signups as in previous years?"

When Wake County made it known MemberHub would no longer be an approved communication tool for schools to use, we knew something had to change. For a long time we were in flux trying to figure out how MemberHub could best be utilized by our PTA to support Jeffreys Grove families. We decided to start over and dismantled the entire infrastructure. This was freeing in a Marie Kondo kind of way:), but it left us with one large hub and no way to know who was interested in what... So we developed a new process.



The new process: We decided that instead of having parents sign up for specialized hubs that may never be utilized, we would create an online directory; thus was born the <u>Volunteer Survey</u>.

Now, when committee leads need help with something, they reference the Volunteer Directory and send their signups to people who have specified an interested in their committee. If the signup fills up they don't have to reach out to the general population.




Advocacy

This week a parent and former PTA president, Ann Mailly, represented JGE and our immersion program on the television show, Education Matters, a show that explores everything from history of public education to the impact of legislation and policy decisions in our public schools.

Ann provided a parent perspective and appeared alongside a principal at Elon Elementary in Burlington which also has an immersion program.
