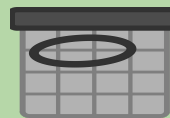
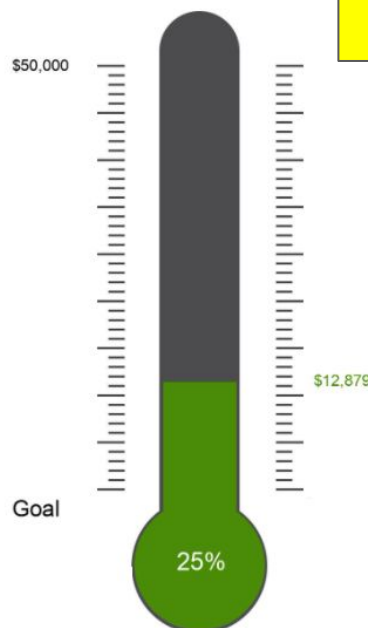
Jeffreys Grove families,

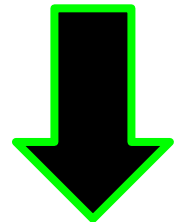

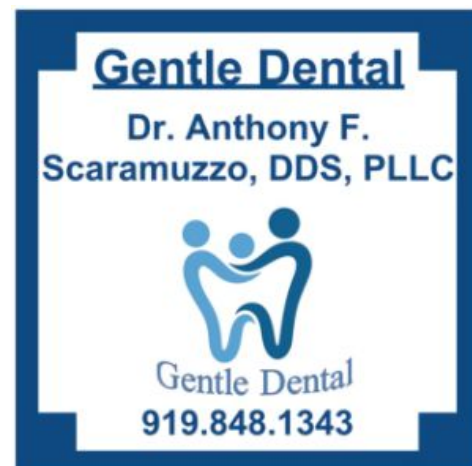
