With the start of the new school year, Wake County Public School students will find a change in the process for boarding the school bus.

In the new boarding process, students will wait until the school bus door opens and the crossing control arm fully deploys before leaving their bus stop to board the bus. In the past, students watched for the stop arm to be fully deployed before walking to the bus.

The new rule: Students wait for the crossing control arm to fully deploy before leaving the sidewalk to board the bus.

Students will find a change in the process for boarding the school bus in Wake County with the start of the new school year.

Much remains the same. Approaching the stop, bus drivers will display flashing amber lights. When they come to a stop, bus drivers will display flashing red lights and extend the stop arm requiring motorists to stop. Drivers will check to see that motorists stopped. Then with a newly installed switch, drivers will open the bus door and deploy the crossing control arm.

The new rule: Students wait for the crossing control arm to fully deploy before leaving the sidewalk to board the bus.
