Strengths:

- Comparing 1st report cards: Q1 to Q3
 - Precalculus up from 73% to 78%
 - Asian improved in CCM2
 - Hispanic improved in English 4
 - LEP improved in CCM3, Am Hist 2
- IMPact
- No long-term suspensions
- Only 77 total suspensions (compared to hundreds at other similar schools)
- Only 2% of student population suspended

Weaknesses

- IMPact
 - Inconsistency in its use by teachers
 - Too much unstructured free time for students
 - Library fills quickly
 - Students sometimes skip because it's IMPact day
- Q3 fewer students with C or better than in Q1
- LEP mostly down
- Black students overrepresented in suspensions

Additional data request: Discipline referral data (Blackburn)

Blackburn: Data Mining

- Question: What explains the difference between grade and EOC scores in classes? Will NCFEs show the same discrepancies?
- NC Math 3 NCFE data
 - Honors Math 3: performance of white, Hispanic, Black, Asian comparable on NCFE
 - Avg Absences per semester: 3.25
 - Students in Honors seem well-placed overall
 - **Academic:** Much higher percent Ds and Fs among Hispanic, Black compared to white (mean score 8 to 10 points lower)
 - Avg Absences per semester: 8
 - Lowest 25% of Hispanic scored lower than lowest white score.
 - 75% of Black students scored lower than median white score

- What explains Academic differences? Is it difficulty of language on exam?
 - *Math 3 is the first 1-semester math class for struggling students (no foundations), high failure rate, statewide issue
 - Attendance is Not the explanation: Many Ds and Fs among students with 10 or fewer absences.

IMPact Questions & Ideas which Loughridge will take to PAC:

- Is there a way to offer more structure, opportunities?
 - Peer tutoring: use the students who are doing well to help others
 - Study hall
 - Meditation room
 - Campus beautification
 - Open gym
 - Students encouraged to stay in room, work on other projects or read
- How is IMPact being used? Survey (Duncan)
 - Make-up work?
 - Remediation?
 - *Best practices for IMPact will depend on what it's being mostly used for
