Welcome back to the start of another exciting year at Ligon GT Magnet Middle School! We hope you had a fun and restful summer and are looking forward to getting back to learning! Our first day back to school is on Monday, August 26th. Students can be dropped off beginning at 7:05 am through the carpool loop on Lenoir Street. Please do not drop off before that time, as there will be no supervision. Students arriving before the first bell at 7:25 can make their way directly to the gym or cafeteria if they are eating breakfast. Please be patient in carpool as the first week is usually backed up. We ask that you give yourself some extra time and not drop students off in random locations around campus. This creates a large safety issue for our students. No drop offs are permitted on Church Street unless they ride special transportation.

If you did not pick up your schedule last week, rosters will be posted on your grade level hallways indicating where you should report.
