FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How much does it cost & how do I register? Parents are encouraged to register online at YMCATriangle.org. If parents are having trouble feel free to contact our Customer Service team (Customer.Service@YMCATriangle.org or 919-719-9989) or visit the SE Raleigh YMCA Welcome Center (1436 Rock Quarry Road). Payment is made through a bank draft, and the cost is **\$28/per 5-day week and \$24/ per 4-day week**. Applications for financial assistance are also available online. This price is only for students who attend Bugg Elementary.

When does before school operate? Monday - Friday, 7:00 - 8:30 (first bell is at 8:15)

Where is before school located? Bugg Magnet Elementary School, 825 Cooper Road

How does drop-off work? From 7:00—7:45 a.m., we run Rides In, a curb-side pickup for your convenience where we will receive your student from your car and escort them inside. Any students arriving after 7:45 am, will need to stay in their car and call our Before School Office Phone at 919-815-6545, we will meet you outside to receive your student. Any students after 8:15 will need to be dropped off at Bugg Magnet Elementary.

What safety measures are now being taken? We take daily health screens and temperatures of all staff and students each day. All staff and students are required to wear masks while inside and while outside if social distancing cannot be maintained.

What will my child do on a typical day? We offer a wide range of activities to engage our students from creative arts to indoor/outdoor games. You will receive a bi-weekly newsletter detailing all of the special events that are happening for the upcoming weeks.

Do you provide breakfast? We do not provide breakfast, but you are welcome to send your child with breakfast to eat once they arrive.

How do you manage medications? We are able to administer both daily and emergency medications. Please bring all medications in their original containers to us on the first day of school along with a medication form. Medication forms will be provided or can be found on our website.

What happens when there is bad weather? On days when snow is anticipated, the YMCA follows decisions made by WCPSS. If school is cancelled, our before school program will also be closed. On days where school is delayed, before school care's start time will be delayed the same increment of time. Please see our website for a more detailed Inclement Weather Policy.
