Teachers at Carnage Magnet Middle school will be using Google products extensively in their Virtual learning experiences. Students can, however, use any digital device- PCs, Macs, iPads, Tablets- to do this work. Desktops, Laptops, and Chromebooks work best. If your child plans to use a tablet, however, we would recommend that you also purchase a keyboard that they can use with that tablet. Your child will be creating lots of written content in their Virtual Classes and that is easier to complete with a keyboard.</p>

Your children will be interacting with teachers and students in virtual meetings spaces like Google Meet. The headphones or earbuds</p>



your child uses will also need a microphone so your child can participate in conversations with teachers and students.

What style should you buy?
