Our Magnet Theme:

As a Gifted & Talented / AIG Basics school, we cultivate and celebrate the unique qualities and needs of each learner. The Gifted & Talented program is rooted in the belief that every student has gifts and talents to be valued and nurtured. Expanded opportunities are provided through extensive elective course choices to enhance the standard curriculum. These opportunities allow students to explore and develop individual interests, gifts, and talents. The AIG Basics program provides instructional grouping to identified students in core subjects as well as academic challenge and acceleration.

Daily Structure:

Students follow an 8-period day which includes four core subjects (English Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies), three elective classes, and a period of lunch and personalized learning.

Electives:

Students have the opportunity to explore a wide variety of subjects and interests through our elective offerings. Electives are offered in all core subjects, world languages, physical education, visual and performing arts, and career and technical education. Many electives are quarter-long while some are a semester or full year.
