- I. The festival is held in the cafeteria and surrounding hallways. Students, teachers, and parents create extraordinary booth displays for different countries around the world! If you have ever been to the Raleigh International Festival, this is very similar. Booths should include the following:
 - A map and flag of the country
 - The name of the country and main languages spoken to display on the front of your table
 - Any artifacts or pictures from the country
 - Any interesting information you can share about your country
 - Samples of foods to give out in small portions (200+ people attend) Remember to have serving utensils, napkins, etc...
 - It is a good idea to dress in typical clothing from the country if at all possible
 - Booths with hand-outs are very popular (little flags, puzzles, visitors' names written in your language on a card)
 - You can also show a video or play typical music
 - A game or activity to add interest beyond your food (something typical to your country)
 - Anything else you want to share!

- II. You must have an adult sponsor at your booth during the festival. The adult sponsor could be a teacher or a parent.

- III. We will have an after-school meeting about a week before the event to see where your booths are located and to go over set up and clean up expectations and procedures. At least one person from your booth should plan to attend. You may stay after school to set up your booth, and you will have time to work on your homework. We will also have some time to visit booths before the festival officially opens.
