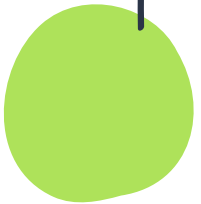

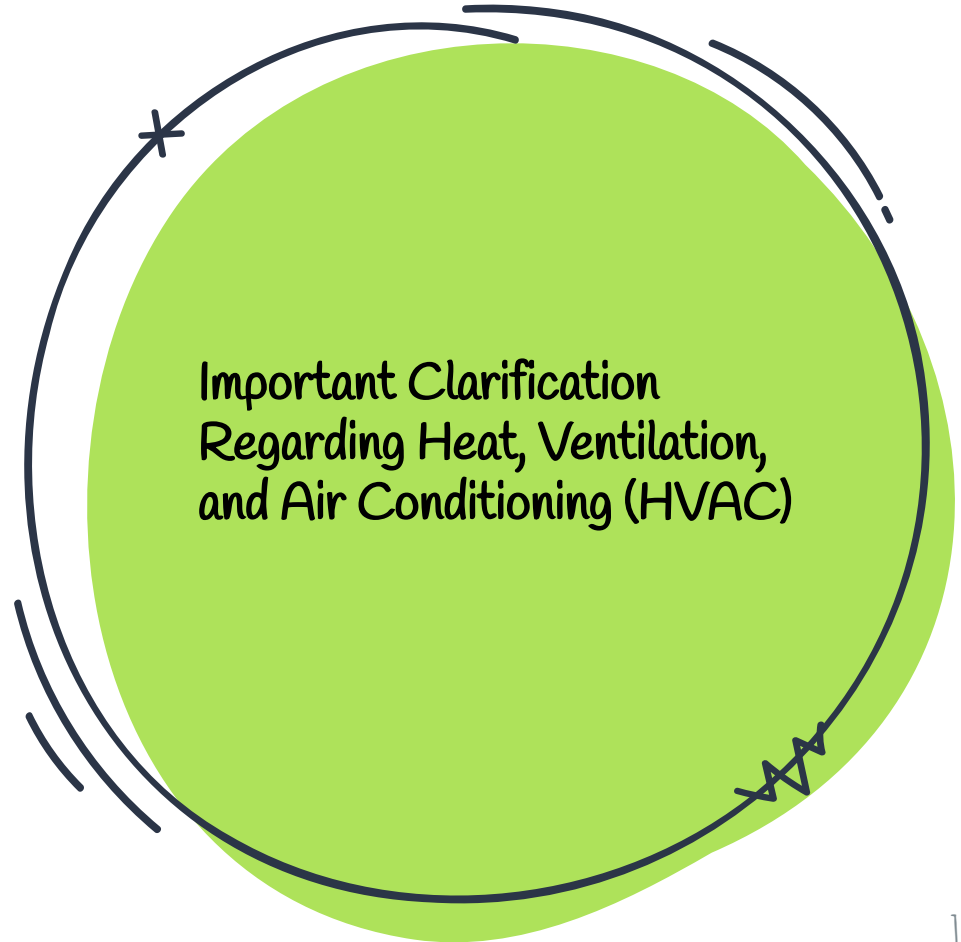

- Systems are monitored and controlled automatically and are turned on one hour before bell time, and off one hour after bell time, unless special events are occurring.
- Filters are changed quarterly.
