

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

Each class will come to the Book Fair two times, for a Viewing and a Buying session. During the Viewing time, your student will create their own "Wish List" of new books they are interested in and will bring that list home. We let all the students explore and choose their own books. You are under no obligation to purchase the books but we hope it will be an opportunity to discuss topics, characters and authors.

### Please be sure to circle or write out the books you want to buy on their Wish List and send it back in with your student.

Each class will come back for a Buying Time to purchase their books. If a book is a "last copy" it must be purchased, then an order is placed and it will be delivered to their classroom as soon as possible.

### **Teacher Wish Lists**

We ask each teacher to fill out yellow Wish List slips for books that they would like to add to their classroom libraries. These lists are available in the Inquiry Center.

Any family can take a slip and purchase a book for any teacher. Gift stickers are available if you would like to include your name in the book.

Mrs. Grice will also have a display of new books on her Wish List to add to the Inquiry Center if you would like to donate a book to FWES.
