Here are a few updates and contest reminders...

Writing Contest

Elementary school students grades K-5 can enter into the [Readvolution Writing Contest](#).

K-2: Why is reading important to me?

- Up to 150 words
- Kindergarten and first grade may include a picture

3-5: Why are team sports important to me?

- Up to 350 words

Farmington Woods will choose (1) winner from grades K-2 and (1) winner from grades 3-5 to represent the school. Entries are due December 12th and should be submitted to the Inquiry Center. Please make sure full name and teacher is on the entry.

Regional Winners will be recognized by the Wake County Board of Education on January 16, 2018 and Winners' names will be featured in the News & Observer!

Student Free Hurricanes Game Ticket Reward Requirements:

- Students need to use the "Continued Reading" option when reading the same book over a period of time to avoid duplicate entries. *Note: Only click "Add New Log" when starting a new book.*
- ALL students must record their books read and log their time DAILY into the Readvolution Dashboard <http://hurricanes.com/WakeCounty>.
- Daily reading requirement is at least 20 minutes a day.
- **Students who achieve their reading goal of 1200 minutes by January 12, 2018 will be able to redeem a Hurricanes game ticket after the campaign has ended. Note: Details and instructions on redeeming tickets will be communicated at a later date.**
